**SCHOOL OF CHOICE  
PROCEDURES for 2006-2007**

A. To minimize disruption for families, parents of English program students may exercise their school of choice option on a “first come, first served basis” using the following additional criteria:

- 1) As a result of the exercise of a school of choice option, no class shall exceed the cap established for each grade level.
- 2) Priority shall be on the basis of the location of the family residence in accordance with the following:

B. When the Student Services Coordinator judges that there are circumstances involving a serious medical condition or extreme family hardship, the Student Services Coordinator shall make a student placement independent of the criteria set forth in A.

C. All other requests shall be considered for “School of Choice” placement provided that the classroom cap is maintained.
