Prior to relocating to The Pas, MB in 2003, Sharain lived and worked in Dartmouth, Nova Scotia. She obtained a Bachelor of Arts in Anthropology from Saint Mary's University in Halifax, NS and a Master of Arts in Museum Studies from the University of Leicester, England.

Currently she is the Director at the Sam Waller Museum here in The Pas, and previously was the Curator at the museum for seven years. Sharain has had a variety of experiences in museums working for the Nova Scotia Museum, Parks Canada and the Black Cultural Centre for

Nova Scotia. Among her various international museum work placements were the Broomfield House Museum in Nottingham, England and the national museums of the Bahamas in Nassau, New Providence and San Salvador Island. Her work experience includes museum event planning, project management and exhibition development.

Among her volunteer commitments since arriving in The Pas have been as a Girl Guide leader, sitting on the board of the local recycling committee, and fund-raising chair for the Northern Juried Art Show. Currently she is a board member of The Pas Arts Council and is the Chair of The Pas Community Renewal Corporation.

First elected as a school trustee in 2018, Sharain chairs the Community Liaison Committee and sits as a member of two other Board committees: Transportation, and Buildings and Maintenance.
